Master Water Specialist Exam Blueprint

The Master Water Specialist (MWS) Exam consists of 100 multiple choice questions to demonstrate broad experience in water treatment design for health-related contaminants and problem water applications at the point-of-use and point-of-entry.

The tasks reflect the following domains:

Gathering Information	12% of exam
Project Management	8% of exam
Specifying Treatment Equipment	6% of exam
Treatment Solution Design	74% of exam
